Areas of Responsibility

1. **Activities:**

2. **Food / Service Preparation:**

- Coordinate the food and service setting preparation for the church-wide activities. This includes monitoring the food/kitchen needs, purchasing supplies, maintaining an adequate inventory of goods in the church kitchen.

3. **Bereavement:**

- Coordinate the immediate response and provide food for bereaved families of the church, either in their home, a church meal, or whatever the request may be.

4. **Funeral Meals**

- Coordinate the food and service setting preparation, if the family desires a meal following a funeral.
